

# KEEFE HAT

## Materials

Berroco Comfort - scraps totaling 147 yds  
Size 7 (4.5mm) circular knitting needles & DPNs  
Stitch Marker  
Tapestry needle  
Crochet hook

## Gauge

20 sts, 30 rows = 4" using size 7 needle

## Abbreviations

CO - cast on  
K - knit  
P - purl  
Sts - stitches  
K2tog - knit the next 2 sts together

## Instructions

With first color, CO 88 sts using long tail method.  
Join for knitting in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker.

P 2 rows  
K 10 rows

Dropping first color and picking up second color,  
K1, P1 around for one row  
K 10 rows

Dropping second color and picking up third color,  
K1, P1 around for one row  
K 10 rows

Dropping third color and picking up fourth color,  
K1, P1 around for one row  
K 10 rows

Dropping fourth color and picking up last color, K1,  
P1 around for one row



K 6 rows, then start decreases, switching to DPNs when it becomes too difficult to knit on circulars

[K2, k2tog] repeat in brackets around (66 sts)

K 1 row

[K1, k2tog] repeat in brackets around (44 sts)

K 1 row

K2tog around (22 sts)

K 1 row

Transfer 11 stitches each to 2 DPNs and work a 3 needle bind off. Keeping last loop live and using crochet hook, chain 10. Make a tassel and secure to end of chain.

Weave in all ends.

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
